

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF SALE

Article 1: application and opposability of the General Terms and Conditions of Sale (hereinafter the "Terms").

The Terms constitute the terms and conditions under which MAISON SCHRÖDER & SCHYLER S.A. (hereinafter the "Seller") governs its sales. Consequently any order implies the customer's full and unreserved acceptance of these Terms and the customer's renunciation of any right to claim the application of any rule or disposition that is contrary to these Terms.

Article 2: applicable law and jurisdiction

Sales made by the Seller, and more generally all commercial relations between the parties, are governed by French law. All dispute shall fall under the exclusive jurisdiction of Bordeaux courts, which shall have sole authority, even in the case of multiple defendants or of the introduction of third parties.

Article 3: offers, orders, tariffs, and acceptance

Offers are always made on the basis of available inventory, and orders received are subject to approval or confirmation by the Seller. The Seller may choose not to process any order received. No refusal by the Seller to conclude an order may be construed as an offence, nor does it give the customer the right to compensation. The order is restricted to the customer, and may not be transferred without the prior written agreement of the Seller.

In the event of noncollection of wine ordered by the customer pursuant to the terms and conditions established by the Seller (and after a period of 60 calendar days from the date established by the Seller), the Seller reserves the right to invoice the customer for inventory costs for storing the wine, and for any losses incurred by the Seller directly or indirectly attributable to the late collection of the products ordered, as well as the right to cancel all or part of the order.

The tariffs presented on the Seller's price list are subject to change, are for information purposes only, and are subject to written confirmation by the Seller. Unless expressly agreed, all prices are understood to be exclusive of tax. Therefore all taxes, VAT, duties, fees, and other amounts owed for the sale, importation, and distribution of wine, notably in application of the national regulations of the Seller and customer or of a transit country, shall be borne by the customer in addition to the price exclusive of tax and in accordance with the procedures set out by current tax laws.

Article 4: transport, delivery, transfer of risk

Sales are transacted from the Seller's storehouse, from the headquarters or the Bordeaux entity, or from any location designated by the Seller. Delivery dates are provided for information purposes only. A delay for any reason whatsoever shall not invoke the Seller's responsibility. The Customer may not cancel an order subsequent to a delivery delay, force majeure, or cause

The delivery, which assures the transfer of title (subject to paragraph 6, "Retention of title"), is understood to be the delivery of the merchandise to the customer or carrier. Whatever the method of shipping and invoicing, the merchandise is transported at the customer's sole risk; the transfer of risk occurs when the merchandise is delivered by the Seller to the customer or carrier. In the event of damage in transport, delay, missing items, or a difference in weight, it is the recipient's responsibility to record any complaint on the carrier's delivery receipt, which must be signed, dated, and confirmed by registered mail within two working days.

Article 5: payment

- The Seller's tariffs are stated exclusive of tax:
- either from the Seller's storehouse, with shipping at additional cost, to a single site in one delivery,
- or including shipping, solely in the event that this condition is mentioned expressly for the tariff in question and in accordance with the procedures, particularly concerning volume, for said tariff, to a single site in one delivery in metropolitan France.

 Any other delivery procedure shall require the Seller's prior express acceptance and may result in amended tariffs.

■ Unless otherwise expressly accepted by the Seller, all invoices are payable at the Seller's headquarters, in cash, in euros (€), on the invoice date, with no discount for early payment.

The Seller reserves the express right to demand prior payment for orders before any delivery. In such a case, the sale will not be complete until payment in full for the order has been received. In the event of nonpayment, the Seller may require that the customer provide credit insurance, in which case the sale will not be complete until such insurance has been obtained. The sale is automatically null and void if said coverage is not provided within one month of the order.

It is understood that the presentation of a payable due does not constitute a payment within the meaning of this clause; the Seller's receivable from the customer retains all related guarantees, including the retention of title, until the payment is fully settled.

- The presentation of bills of exchange or the acceptance of commercial paper implies neither dispensation at the place of payment, which is Bordeaux, nor novation or dispensation from the clause conferring jurisdiction. In the event of exceptional extension of the agreements accorded by the Seller, bank charges and fees shall be at the expense of the customer, who shall be required to pay, in addition to the principal due, all fees for extension and interest for deferral.
- By the sole effect of the agreed-on sale and the present Terms, the customer accepts the irrevocable obligation to pledge the goods that are the subject of this document in order to guarantee any amount that it might owe the Seller, whatever the origin of the amount, which may occur in the execution of the present document or of another document and/or sales contract before or after the present document for the same goods or services, or for other goods or services than those covered by the present document. To satisfy this obligation, the customer shall declare immediately and irrevocably to pledge to the Seller, as guarantee of any amount that it might owe the Seller, pursuant to Articles L.521-1 et seq. of the French Commercial Code, the ownership of goods that the Seller would accord him subsequent to the present document or any other document and/or sales contract before or after the present document for the same goods or services or for other goods or services than those covered by the present contract. The Seller's right of retention extends not only to goods covered by the present document but also to all goods belonging to the same customer. Those good constitute a real guarantee for payment of any amount due to the Seller by said customer, on any grounds whatsoever.
- Unless expressly agreed by the Seller, any payment made by the customer shall be charged to the longest outstanding invoice due from said customer to the Seller, regardless of the type
- No payment date can be deferred without the prior express consent of the Seller. Late-payment penalties shall be due the day after the payment date stated on the invoice, in the event that the amounts due are paid after this date. By express agreement, regardless of the method of payment and without prior warning, any amount remaining unpaid the day after the payment date stated on the invoice shall be automatically increased by late-payment interest equal to three times the going rate, by all collection and legal expenses, by an additional flat-rate penalty
- of 10% and by a fixed sum of € 40, as compensation for recovery costs (Decree 2012-1115).

 In addition, the nonpayment of a single invoice allows the Seller, at its discretion, to demand immediate settlement for the amount due for all outstanding invoices. The Seller may:
 - defer the performance of orders under way until guarantees or new procedures for payment guarantee have been provided to the Seller.
 - suspend its obligations as regards the order concerned by the late payment, as well as all other orders under way, until full payment has been received for the amounts due from the customer.
 - automatically cancel the order; the Seller may then take back ownership of the wine concerned. This cancellation will affect not only the order under way but also all or part of past or future orders, delivered or due to be delivered, whose payment is outstanding or not. Deposits made by the customer shall be retained by the Seller.
 - compensate for the amount of the unpaid invoice by the amounts due eventually to the customer from the Seller.
- In the event of nonpayment at the payment date for any invoice whatsoever, and after a period of 10 days following a warning made by the Seller via registered mail with acknowledgement of receipt, the sale will be automatically cancelled at the Seller's discretion. The foregoing shall be without prejudice to further claims for damages.

Article 6: retention of title

By express agreement, the Seller reserves the right of retention of title to the merchandise provided until full payment has been received, pursuant to the terms and conditions of Act 80.335 of May 12, 1980. In the event of resale before the purchase price has been paid in full, the claim for title shall be carried out on the basis of the full or partial resale price. This clause is expressly accepted by the customer, which declares that it has examined the present clause and accepted it without reservation. Once the wine has been delivered (as defined in Article 4 above), these dispositions shall not prevent the transfer to the customer of the risks for loss or damage of the goods subject to retention of title, as well as damages they might incur. The customer shall purchase insurance covering all risks, beginning on or after the delivery of the wine ordered, and allowing for direct compensation to the Seller.

The customer may not pledge or transfer under any form whatsoever, as guarantee, the ownership of the wine. The wine may be taken back at any time and without prior notice, at the customer's expense, by the Seller, in the event of nonfulfillment of the customer's obligations, in addition to payment of damages to the Seller. This procedure is not exclusive of other actions or legal proceedings that the Seller may resolve to undertake.

Article 7: specific terms and conditions for the sale of wine futures (en primeur)

In the specific case of wine futures, the following terms and conditions confirm or exempt the aforementioned terms and conditions.

a) Collection

The collection or delivery of vintage T wine with delivery included shall occur no later than June 30 of the year T+3. The storage of the wine shall be at the expense of the Seller until this date. During the 60 days preceding this expiration date (June 30 of year T+3), the customer is responsible for informing the Seller of the exact date on which it intends to collect or have delivered the wine, in accordance with the procedures set forth in the initial sales agreement. Without exception and after this date (June 30 of year T+3), the Seller shall invoice for storage of the wine at the current rates as stated on the pro forma invoice; the risks incurred by the wine shall be at the expense of the customer.

b) Invoicing
Orders for wine futures shall be invoiced in accordance with the laws in force, exclusive of tax, by pro forma invoice issued upon receipt of the order, payable pursuant to the procedures set forth in Article 5 above (except for payment dates expressly accepted by the Seller or stated in the sales offer or the pro forma invoice). VAT, delivery, and any storage and related additional charges shall be invoiced and payable upon delivery of the wine and upon presentation of the final invoice. In the event of a change in the tax rules governing this point, the new tax rule shall automatically apply to the customer, including for any orders under way.

No order shall be handed over or delivered to the customer if one of the invoices issued to the customer remains payable, even partially, at its due date, whether concerning one or several

initial pro forma invoices for the price exclusive of tax of wine futures (year T), any subsequent final invoice for the same order (including VAT, shipping, storage, etc.), or any other invoice issued for the same customer, including for another order.
